

Household Waste Recycling Centre

Waste acceptance policy

If you are undertaking a large DIY project such as a building renovation it is recommended that you hire a skip as this waste is not classified as household waste. All DIY type waste delivered to the site will be inspected prior to you being able to deposit it. Any large amounts will be refused and you will need to make alternative arrangements for its disposal. The following restrictions also apply:-



hardcore
& rubble



soil

The HWRC will accept the equivalent of two standard sized refuse sacks of soil, rubble and tiles per visit. Soil, rubble and tile waste must be brought to the site separately bagged or boxed and then emptied directly into the correct container. This quantity restriction applies whatever vehicle is being used to transport the material.



plasterboard

The site has a dedicated storage container for plasterboard as it must be segregated from other waste types. Please ask site staff for assistance. As with other DIY waste, plasterboard is not classified as household waste but we can accept one standard sized refuse sack arising from minor DIY projects per visit.



asbestos

Asbestos cannot be deposited at the site. You will need to contact an alternative waste company.



Any item suitable for re-use should be handed to a site operative.
