GATING OF A PUBLIC FOOTPATH ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 129A

(GATING OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH C62, FROM CHURCH ROAD TO
SUMMER HILL ROAD COSELEY) ORDER 2008

This Order is made by the Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council ("the Council") under Section 129A of the Highways Act 1980 upon being satisfied that the following conditions have been met:-

- (a) Premises adjoining or adjacent to the highway are affected by crime or anti-social behaviour;
- (b) The existence of the highway is facilitating the persistent commission of criminal offences or anti-social behaviour; and
- (c) It is in all the circumstances expedient to make the Order for the purposes of reducing crime or anti-social behaviour.

BY THIS ORDER:

That length of public footpath C62 which commences adjacent to Number 29A Church Road running in an easterly direction for approximately 20 metres turning north easterly for approximately 140 metres to terminate adjacent to Number 59 Summer Hill Road will be restricted by gating along the path which is shown on plan TMD/CP/48/GO.

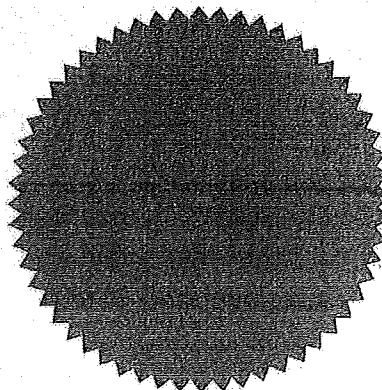
The above length of path will be closed to pedestrians at all times.

The alternative route is via Church Road, Philip Street and Summer Hill Road, Coseley.

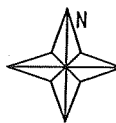
