Re: Path at Christ Church Lye

We write to give notice through the Highways Act 1980 (Section 31 sub section 6) concerning the opening of a new gate on the northern boundary of the Church land into the new Christ Church Park. The Christ Church Park is the new park that the Council has developed adjacent to the Lye By-Pass. Two plaques have been erected on site as marked on the enclosed plan. The working of the two plaques is as follows:

"Highways Act 1980 Section 31 (3). This Churchyard has not been dedicated as a highway, bridleway or footpath nor is there any intention to dedicate it. Christ Church The Lye and Stambermill PCC".

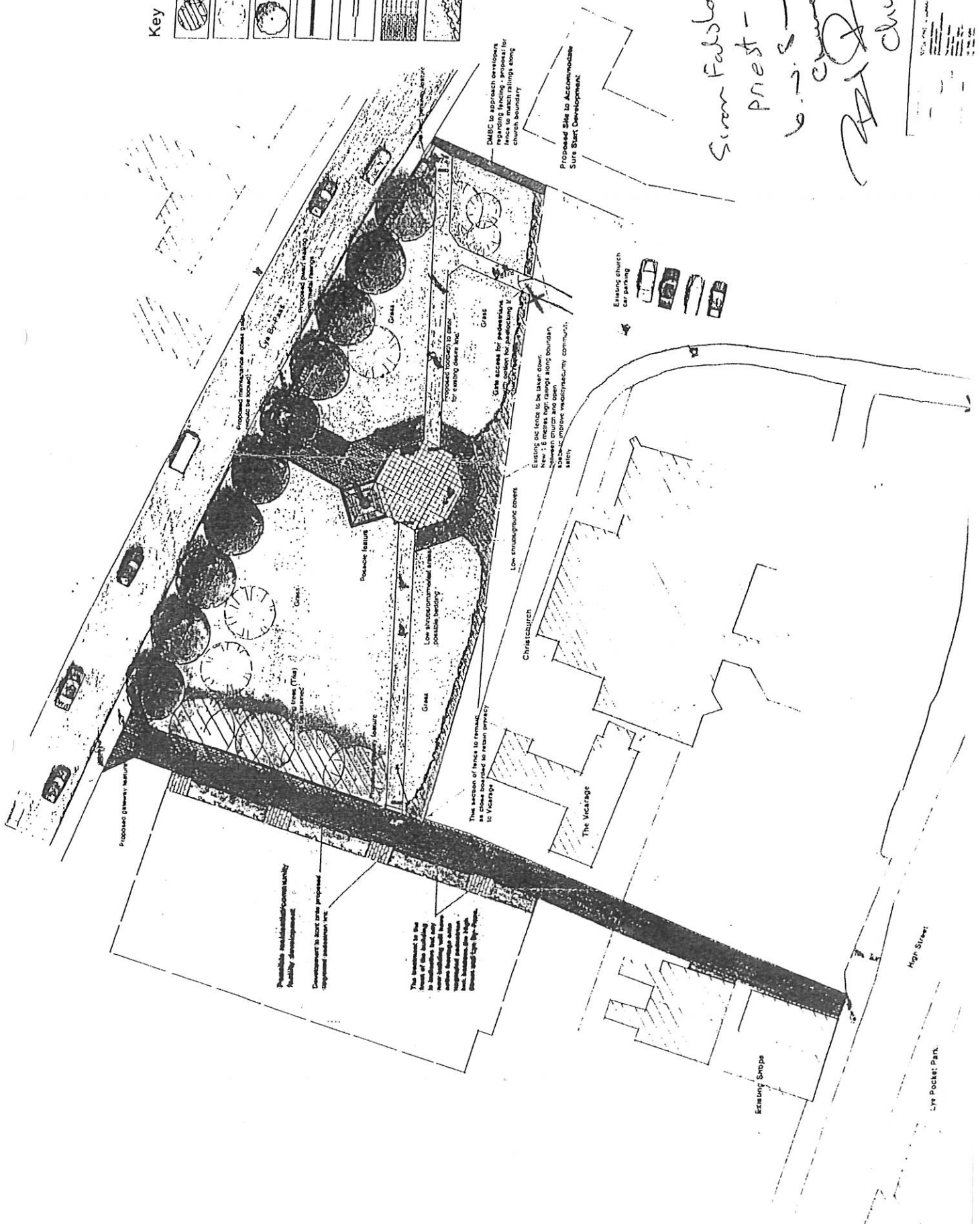
