



ADOPTION STATEMENT

SHOPFRONT AND ADVERTISEMENT – SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT 2017

Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council adopted the Shopfront and Advertisement Supplementary Planning Document on 13th September 2017. This adoption statement is required by Regulation 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2012.

Title of Document: Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council Shopfront and Advertisement Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) 2017.

Subject Matter: The Shopfront and Advertisement SPD 2017 provides guidance to anyone involved in the process of commissioning or designing new or replacement shop fronts and advertisements, or the alterations of existing ones. The SPD applies to historical or traditional buildings but also to new buildings and modern frontages.

Area of Document: The Shopfront and Advertisement SPD applies to the entire Dudley Metropolitan Borough i.e. the administrative area of Dudley Metropolitan Borough Council.
