Waste collections

Households will have altered waste and recycling collections between Monday 24 December to Friday 4 January

Household waste recycling centre (HWRC)

The household waste recycling centre will be closed on December 25 and 26 and January 1.

Leisure Centres

Dudley

The centre will be closed from December 24 to 26 and January 1. The centre will close at 3pm on December 22 and 23 and 27 to 31.

Crystal

The centre will be closed December 24 to 26 and January 1. The centre will close at 6pm December 27 to 31. The Leisure Pool will be closed for essential maintenance from December 17 to January 1.

Halesowen

The centre will be closed from December 24 to 26 and January 1. The centre will close at 4.45pm December 22 and 23 and 29 to 31 and 8.30pm December 27 and 28.

Dell Stadium

The Dell will close at 5.00pm on December 23 and reopen at 9.00am on January 2.

Coseley Sports Centre

The centre will close at 6.00pm on December 23 and reopen at 4.30pm on January 2.

Park activity centres

Libraries

Dudley Archives and Local History Centre

Dudley Museum and Red House Glass Cone

Children's, adult and community services

Offices will be closed December 22 to January 2.

Housing services

Offices will close 4.30pm December 21 and re-open 8am January 2.

Services including residential care and homecare will continue to operate during the holiday period. The homeless service team will operate from Dudley Council Plus (see above for the centre's opening times).

The Repairs Management Centre will be closed between December 24 to 26 and January 1.

Only emergency housing repairs will be undertaken from December 23 through to January 1 inclusive. Please call 0300 555 8283 to report any emergencies on these days 24 hours a day.

Dementia Gateway services

The Crystal Gateway will be closed December 24 to 26 and January 1.

Brett Young will be closed December 21 to January 1. Normal service will resume at both centres on January 2.

Bereavement services

The cemeteries and crematoria grounds are open throughout the Christmas period from 9am until 4.30pm with the book of remembrance room open 9am to 4pm. The offices will be closed December 24, 25, 26 and January 1.
